Key Responsibilities

The Graduate Business Development Fellow will work directly with the Program Manager and Marketing team to support Cause Effective's work with clients, marketing efforts and strategic growth. The direct goal of this support will be to enhance Cause Effective's markets and audience development. As a member of the Cause Effective team, they will keep programs and marketing work on schedule (mostly in relation to workshops), assure marketing and communications materials are prepared—including owning pieces of the business development scope, and devising and implementing new marketing strategies.

The Graduate Business Development Fellow will work 20 hours per week, with an expectation of two 8-hour days and one 4-hour day in the office during the work week. There may be evenings where participation in trainings are required.

We ask that candidates be available and committed to joining Cause Effective for the academic year, starting early September and ending May 8th, 2020. With good performance, the Graduate Business Development Fellow may have the opportunity to continue their position through the summer as a paid position.
